

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LOCATION AND ACCESSIBILITY

In the south of the province of Limburg, where rolling hills, picturesque church villages and swaying grain fields alternate with each other, lies the Heart of Haspengouw. This beautiful Landscape Park is more than just a nature reserve: it is an ancient cultural landscape brimming with conviviality and history. **Sint-Truiden** is the capital of Haspengouw, but just outside Sint-Truiden's borders, the Haspengouw scenery spreads across **Borgloon**, Wellen, Kortessem, Diepenbeek, Hoeselt, Tongeren and Heers.

- Discover art with PIT

Walk or cycle through the rolling hills of Borgloon and the area round about and discover PIT, **Art in the open air**. This unique project involves six extraordinary artworks that are the perfect blend of art, architecture and landscape.

The artworks in PIT invite you to look at the nature in the Loon district in a different way. They enhance the beauty of the landscape, tell stories about the region and make you think. Let yourself be surprised by the creativity of the artists and experience how art can enrich nature.

One of the absolute highlights of PIT is the see-through church by Gijs Van Vaerenbergh (Pieterjan Gijs and Arnout Van Vaerenbergh). This 10-metre-high sculpture, made of stacked steel plates, resembles the type of small church found in the Loon district. The special construction means the landscape always remains visible, both from a distance and from close up.

As well as the see-through church, you can enjoy other works of art, such as:

Follow the Romans — through Haspengouw

For four hundred years, the Romans left their mark on South Limburg. Take a journey through time and experience the fascinating legacy of the Romans in Heart of Haspengouw. See where mighty villas once stood, admire remnants of Roman roads or explore the tumuli; imposing burial mounds where affluent Romans were laid to rest.

This unique walk takes you to:

- The Roman ramparts: Tongeren was one of the few cities north of the Alps that had a stone city wall in Roman times. Explore the remains of this majestic fortress and imagine yourself back in time.
- Beukenberg aqueduct: A true testimony to the ingenious Roman hydraulic engineering system. Admire the man-made ridge that served as an aqueduct and imagine how spring water once flowed along it to the city.
- Tumuli: See these mysterious burial mounds where the elite of Roman society found their final resting place.
- The Betho castle domain: Stroll through the idyllic surroundings of this former moated castle and enjoy the peace and beauty of the Haspengouw countryside.
- Panoramic views: Climb the hills and enjoy breathtaking views over the rolling Haspengouw region with Tongeren's imposing belfry tower as backdrop.

A JOURNEY THROUGH TIME

Immerse yourself in Tongeren's rich history with a visit to the <u>Teseum</u> or the Gallo-Roman Museum!

Fruit farming: — From orchard to pot

For centuries, each spring, the rolling hills of Haspengouw have been coloured with blossoming fruit trees. In the autumn, these beautiful trees produce an abundance of delicious fruit: apples, pears, plums, cherries, strawberries and a variety of berries.

Taste the fruits — of their work:

- Fruit farm 't Bommerhof (Sint-Truiden): Apples, pears, strawberries. Open to visitors on Saturdays in April and on the first two Saturdays in May at 10:30 a.m.
- Fruit farm Wilderhof (Sint-Truiden): Soft fruits such as raspberries, blackberries, blueberries and strawberries. Open to visitors on Thursdays in April and on the first two Thursdays of May at 10:30 a.m.
- <u>Regional produce shop 't Vijverhof (Kortessem)</u>:
 Wide range of local produce, including fruit, jams,
 juices, honey, and more.

The sun slipping through the leaves of the trees, creating a mesmerising light show on your unique sleeping spot. You step outside, stretch your arms and take a deep breath of the fresh morning air. This is no ordinary campsite; this is the **Tranendreef in Haspengouw**, where you sleep in a work of art among the trees!

The Tranendreef is more than a place to sleep, it is an adventure. Here, you experience nature in a unique manner, far away from the daily hustle and bustle. The tents, designed by **artist Dré Wapenaar**, are not only eye-catching but also comfortable and practical. They can accommodate two adults and two children and are equipped with all the necessities for an unforgettable night.









Cycle routes

Comparing apples and pears

Explore rolling hills covered with fruit trees, take in the breathtaking panoramas and relax in picturesque church villages. A few enjoyable beer stops on this route provide some extra buzz.

From fruit to syrup

This challenging cycling loop in Borgloon takes you through a landscape rich in diversity. Climb the hills and enjoy beautiful views of colourful fruit tree orchards, picturesque church villages and ancient castles.

• Distance: 38 km

• **Departure point:** Fruit experience centre Stroopfabriek (Borgloon)

Cycle past heritage and castles

Cycle through the rolling fruit country of Haspengouw and immerse yourself in the Roman past of Tongeren, Belgium's oldest city. Along the way, you can stop for a wine at Belgium's only wine chateau.

• **Departure point:** Land Commandery Alden Biesen (Bilzen)

Cycling along tumuli

Climb rolling hillsides and enjoy unique views of fruit tree orchards and explore special places along the Old Roman Road.

Orchards, forests and castles

This route takes you through a varied landscape of fruit plantations, church villages and castles. Cycle through the forest area Domain Nieuwenhoven and climb the hill in Zepperen for a spectacular view. Also look out for the beautiful St Roch's church in Ulbeek.

The Flanders' Finest Cycle Routes take you to all the wonderful things Flanders has to offer. Cycle through surprising landscapes and past unique heritage. Fruity landscapes with PIT

Few places taste as sweet as the Haspengouw, the fruit region par excellence. On this tour, you cruise through the rolling landscape full of orchards, art in the open air, heritage and fruity treasures.

Walking routes

Herkbeemden - yellow walking route

This short walk is perfect for beginners. It takes you through meadows and marshes, past a picnic area, wooden bridges, grazing Scottish Highland cattle and rare plants and animals.

• Distance: 3.1 km

This route is perfect for those who love history. You walk by the remains of the Roman city wall, visit a Roman aqueduct and even pass a castle.

• **Distance**: 7.8 km

Bellevue Forest - red walking route

This walking route takes you through a varied landscape. You walk through the Hemelspark, past fields and fruit tree orchards, and through the forest with its rich fauna and flora. Extra bonus: this forest has an area where dogs can roam off the leash!

Fruit Valley - blue walking route

The Fruit Valley walk is an ideal outing for the whole family. Walk through high-stem orchards and apple plantations, along the Molenbeek and explore the natural playground with slide.

• **Distance:** 3.3 km

• Departure point: Sint-Truiden

Mettekoven - red walking route

This walk takes in rolling hills, vast fields and charming villages. Along the way, enjoy the beautiful views and, in the spring, you find yourself in a sea of blossoms. This walk is perfect for those looking for a bit of a challenge while enjoying the beautiful nature of Haspengouw.
